Terms of Reference for national climate finance consultant in Uganda

Background:

The Global Support Programme receives funding from the GEF and is jointly implemented by the United Nations Development Program (UNDP) and United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP). It is in this context that UNEP DTU Partnership through UNEP provides technical assistance to a range of countries on different areas of NDC implementation.

Many developing countries are currently thinking of ways to mobilize resources for meeting their climate change targets in their NDCs. However, the amount of climate finance flowing to the African countries remains well below the estimated needs. Developing countries are already keen to mobilize climate finance from both domestic and international sources for climate action to meet their mitigation targets under the Paris Agreement. A mix of public – both domestic and international - and private sector finance are required to support action at the scale needed. In recent years, Uganda has focused on getting ready to implement its NDC and climate change strategies as well as frameworks including the National Climate Change Policy and the Green Growth Development Strategy.

Objective:

The objective of this consultancy is to support the Climate Change Department and the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development to organize and facilitate a workshop focusing on how lessons learned related to establishing instruments for climate finance for NDC implementation from countries in the region.

Detailed consultancy activities:

- Organize a workshop in close collaboration with the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development, Climate Change Department and UNEP DTU Partnership on national financial vehicles for NDC implementation in Kampala taking place in the last week of February 2020 with participation from experts in the region
- Facilitate and moderate the workshop
- Develop a workshop report with key findings from the different workshop sessions

Deliverables:

- Regional workshop on national financial vehicles for NDC implementation organized with support from the Climate Change Department and UNEP DTU Partnership
- Workshop report developed with key findings from the discussions.
