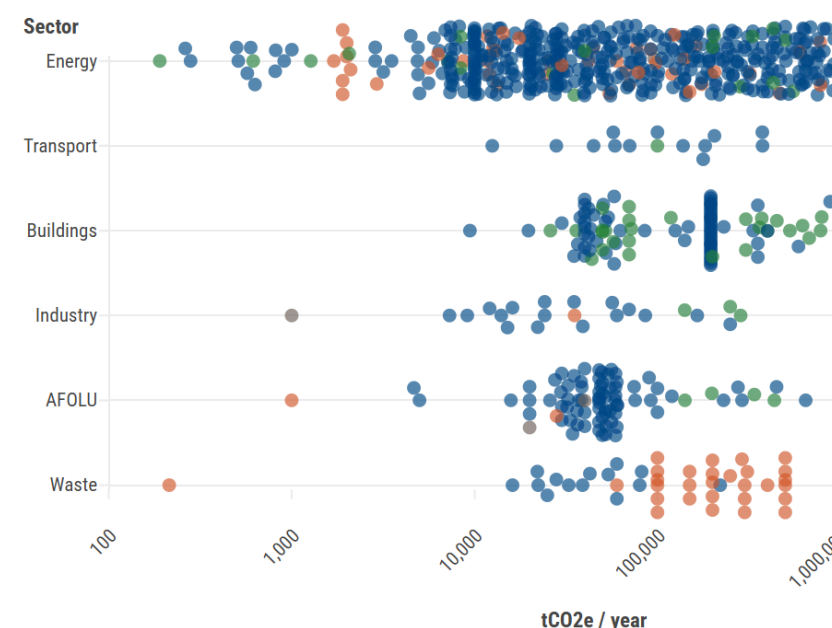

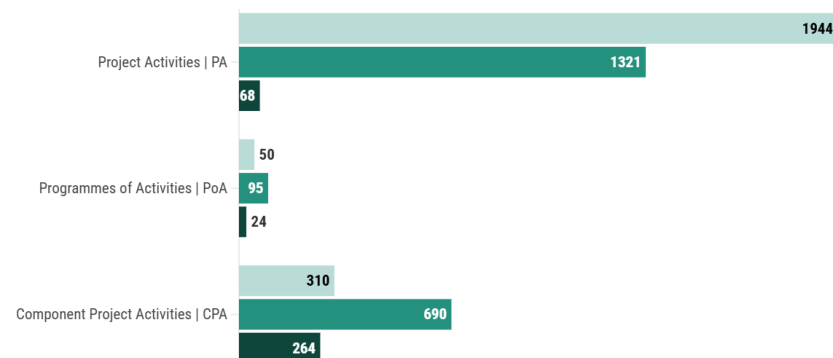

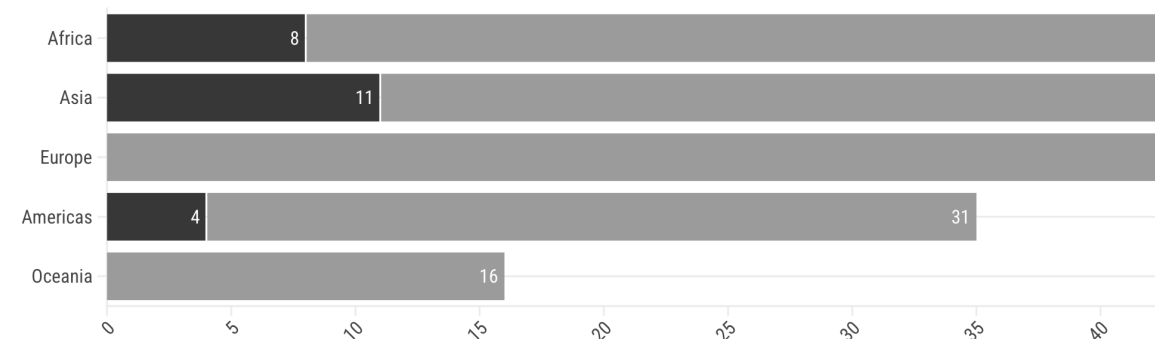
WITH NEW PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS FORM

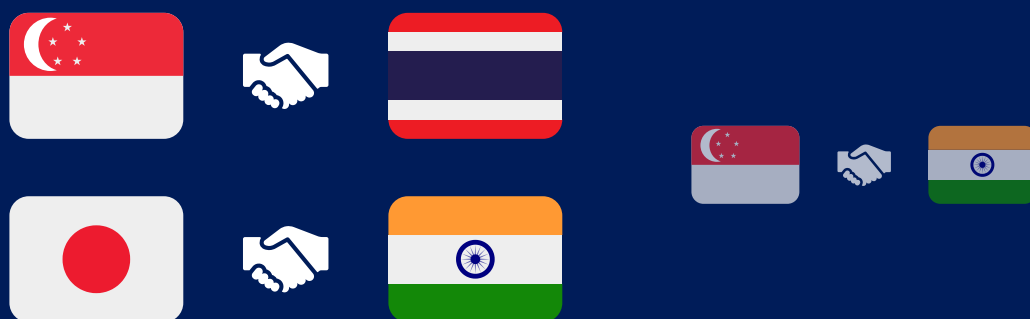

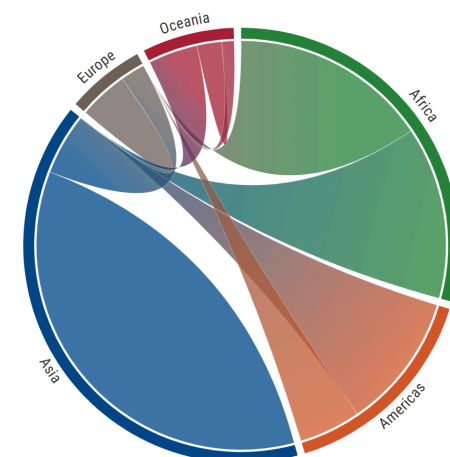

Number of agreements between countries by region (host and buyer)



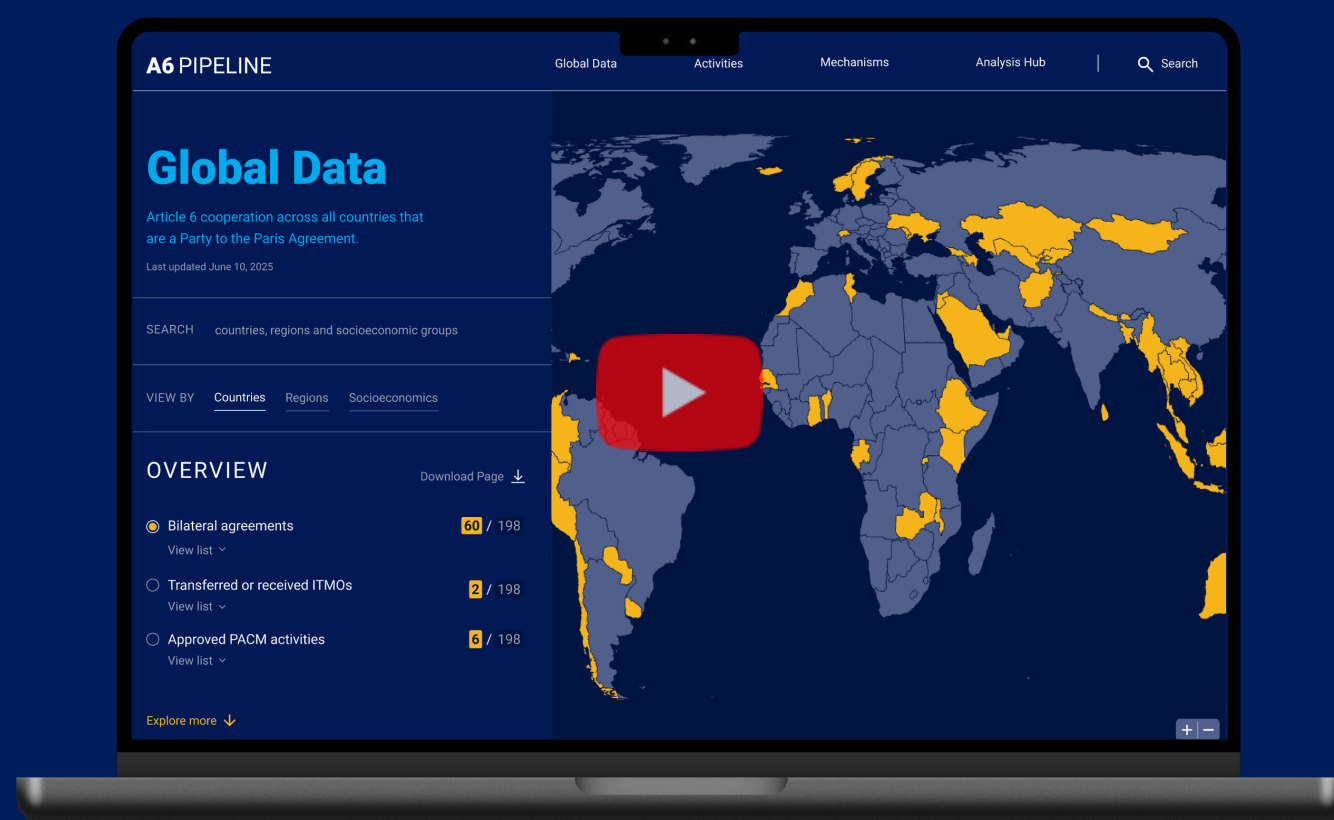
