

ESTIMATED MITIGATION POTENTIAL PER YEAR





Jordan is the 23rd country to submitt their PACM participation requirements form, providing information on sustainable development impacts and the types of activities they may approve.





As part of their cooperation with Switzerland, one new cookstove project in Senegal and one electric vehicle programme in Peru are being set up


