# Transition

PACM

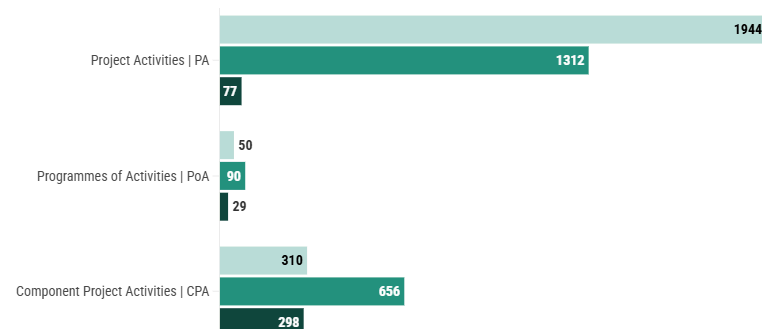
At COP 30 in Belém, Parties decided to extend the deadline for host Party approval for CDM transition requests to 30 June 2026.

This provides more time for the majority of requests to progress to the next stage of the transition to PACM.

## CDM Transition Requests

Activities that were registered under the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) and may join the new Paris Agreement Crediting Mechanism (PACM) under Article 6.4

## OF CDM ACTIVITIES REQUESTING TRANSITION HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY HOST PARTIES

Since mid-November, 8 activities were approved by host Parties (Benin, Madagascar, Morocco, and Panama) including 2 multi-Party programmes which had already previously received approval by another country.

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# National Arrangements

## PACM

An increasing number of countries has taken steps towards PACM participation by appointing their Designated National Authorities (DNAs).

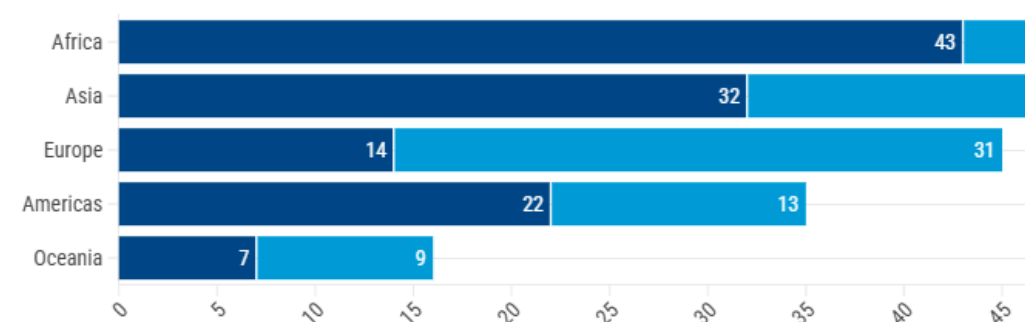

### Parties with and without DNA by region

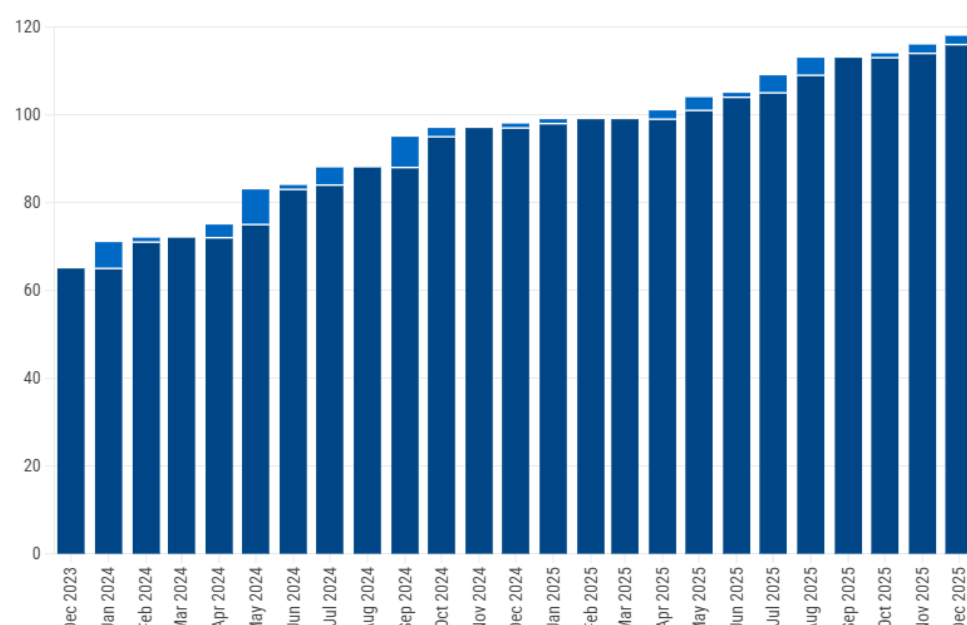
Parties with DNA Parties without DNA

# National Arrangements

## PACM

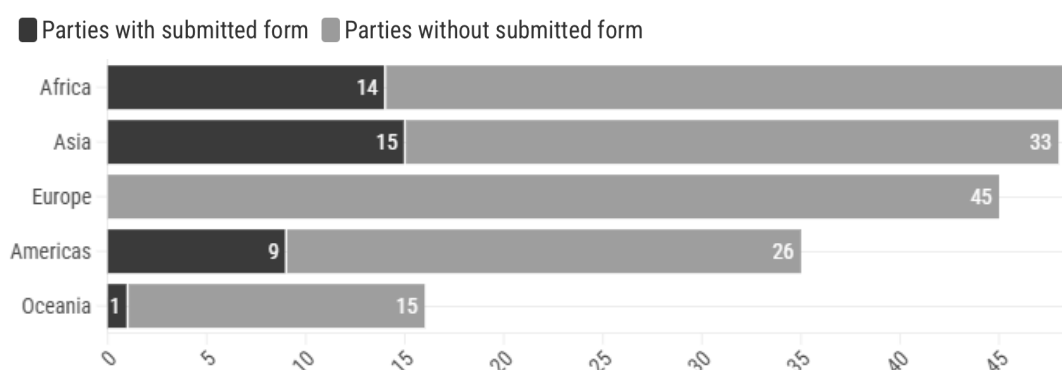
39 countries have submitted their host Party Participation forms.

This form is prerequisite for any country's approval of CDM transitions and new PACM activities. With the extended deadline for CDM transition approval, host countries will also have more time to submit this form.

WITH HOST PARTY PARTICIPATION FORMS

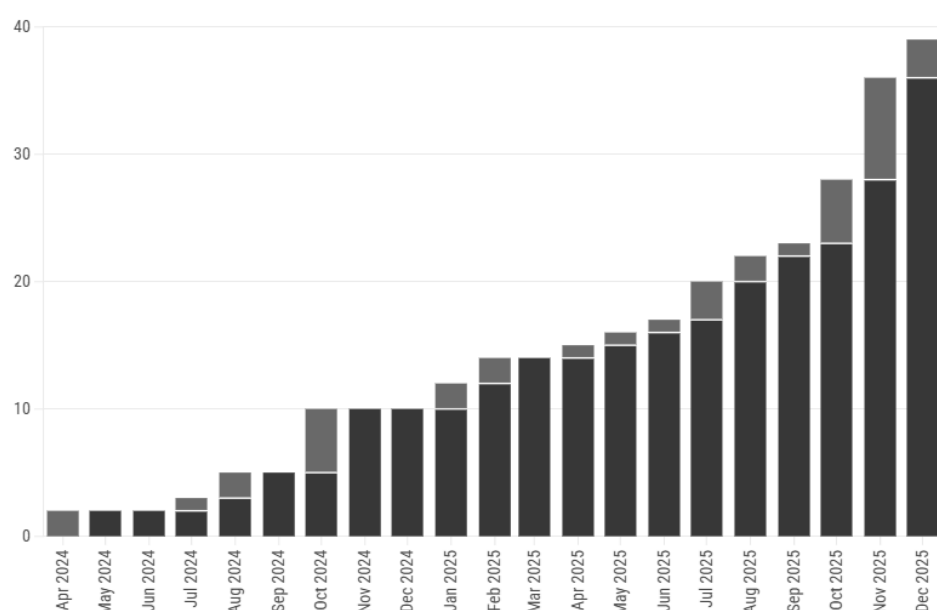
### Parties with and without Participation Requirements form by region

With the original deadline for approval of CDM transitions approaching, the submissions have accelerated.

Since mid-November, 3 countries (Azerbaijan, Costa Rica, and Ethiopia) have submitted their Host Party Participation forms.



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# Pipeline of PACM Activities

## PACM

Alongside CDM transitions, activity proponents submit Prior Consideration Notifications for new PACM activities. Since mid-November, 5 new activities were proposed, bringing the total to 1,097.

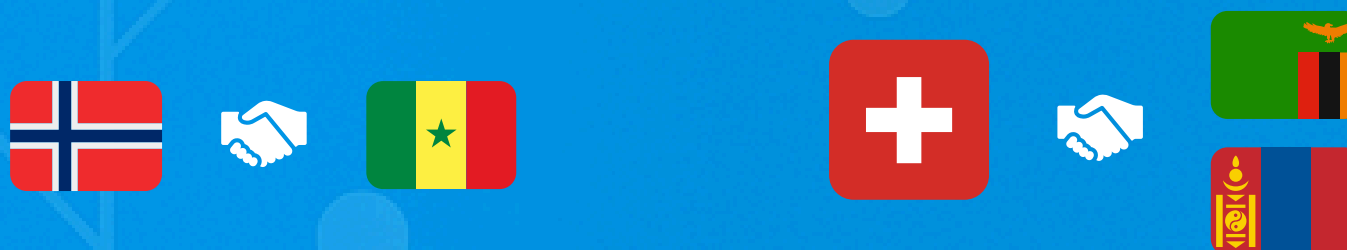

Signed implementation agreements are paving the way for country-to-country cooperation.



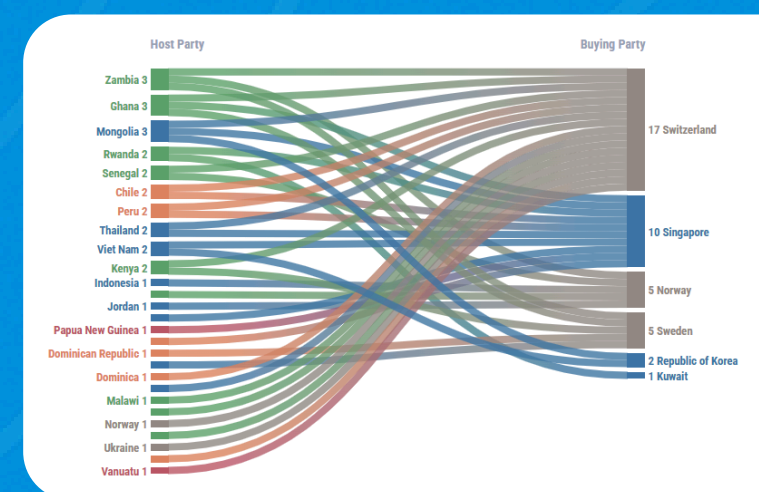
In Belém, three implementation agreements were signed between Norway and Senegal, Switzerland and Mongolia, and Switzerland and Zambia.

<sup>2</sup> This does not include signed “Memoranda” for cooperation under Japan’s Joint Crediting Mechanism (JCM). Japan’s cooperation through the JCM, currently includes 31 partner countries. In total, 106 agreements were signed between 62 different countries.

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# Bilateral Cooperation

Initial reports covering an increasing number of cooperative approaches were submitted - alongside recommendations from expert reviews.

Most approaches (28) for cooperation are under Japan's Joint Crediting Mechanism. Another 7 approaches currently have no partner country identified.

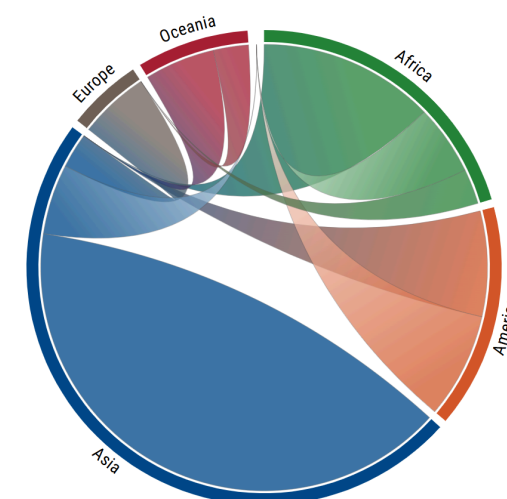
Some initial reports have undergone technical expert review (TER), with the first findings and recommendations now published.<sup>3</sup> In Belém, Parties requested technical expert reviews to clearly explain inconsistencies identified through the TER process and provide recommendations to resolve them.

Since mid-November, Rwanda submitted their first initial report including two cooperative approaches under the MoUs signed with Singapore and Sweden.

Number of Cooperative Approaches between countries by region (host and buyer)



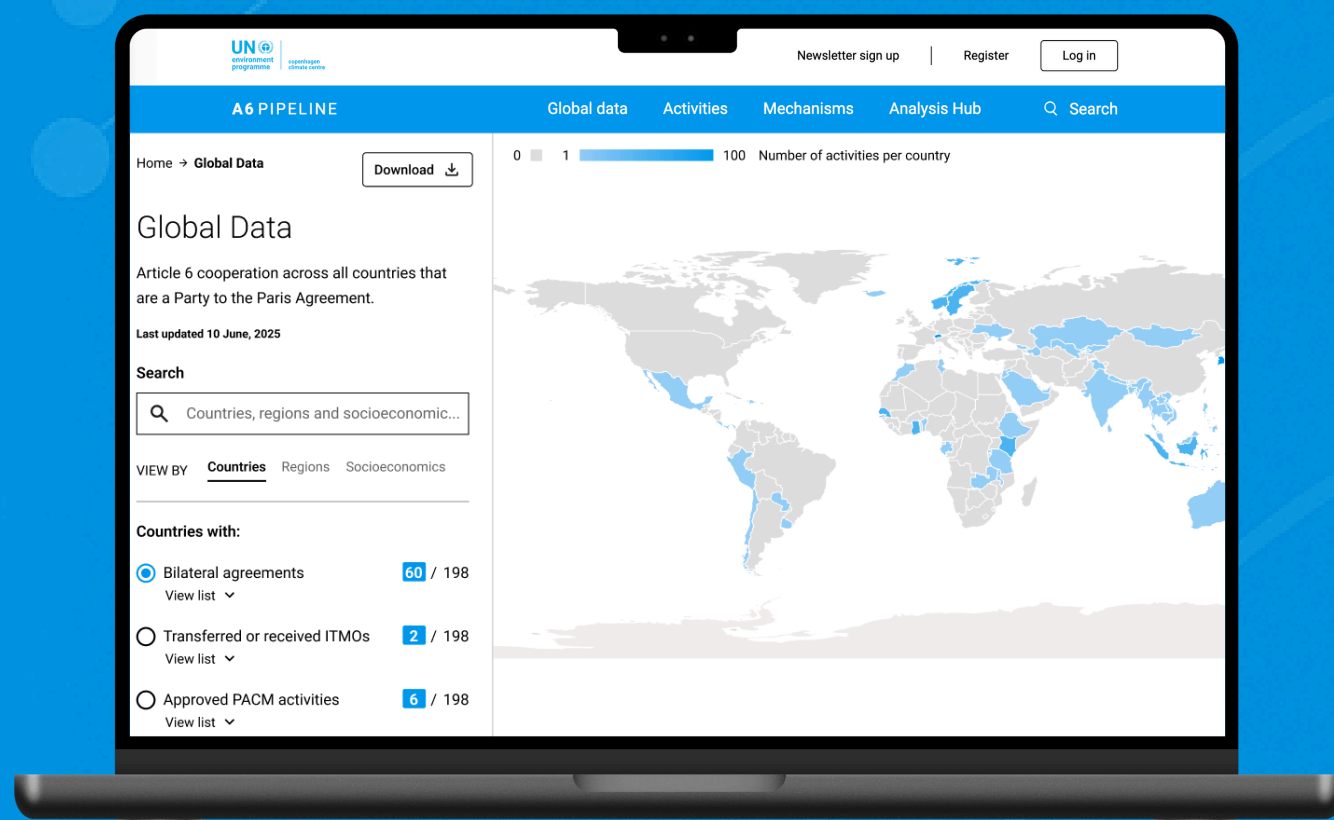
