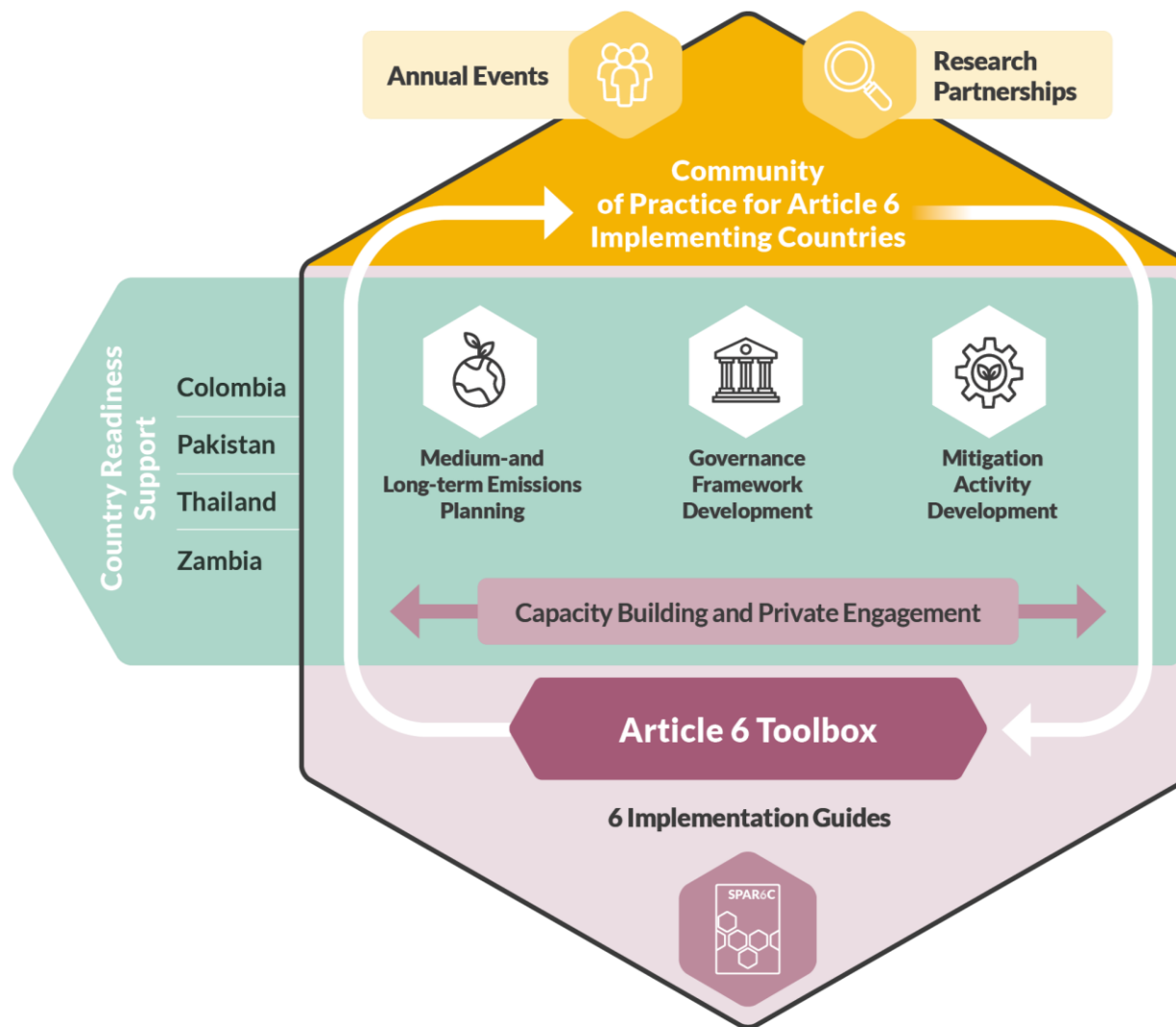

- Development of 3 Sectoral studies



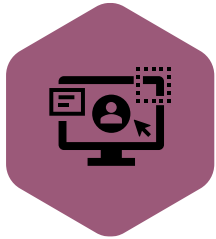
- Development of a project pipeline consisting of 16 Project ideas notes (MAINs) for consideration as Article 6 activity

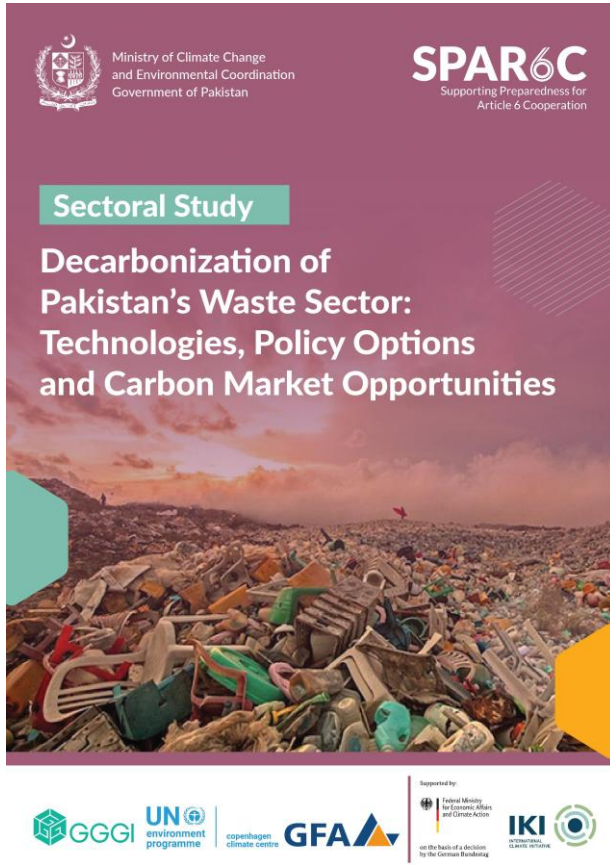

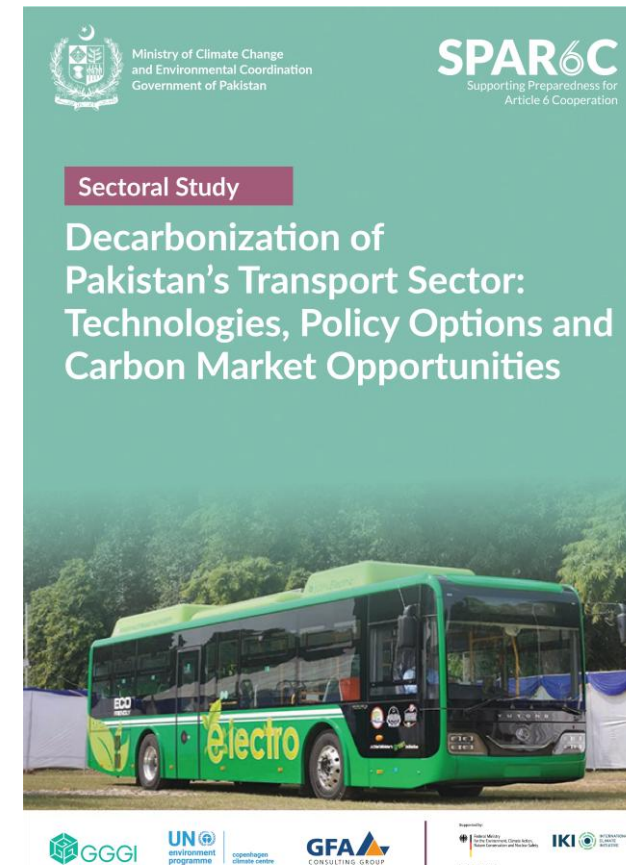
