# Article 6 Pipeline history and aim



The UNEP Copenhagen Climate Centre (formerly UNEP DTU Partnership and UNEP Risø Centre) set up and developed **the CDM Pipeline database since 2002**



In 2023, UNEP-CCC **transitioned the CDM Pipeline to the Article 6 Pipeline** and compiled data and information on new Article 6 activities in an Excel database



As the rules and activities develop, the data is **updated monthly** and visualized on the UNEP CCC website



The Article 6 Pipeline is now transformed and launched as an interactive and user-friendly **web-based platform**

The aim is to provide insights on the development of Article 6 activities and their impacts on countries' national climate targets (NDCs) and SDGs at the national and global level

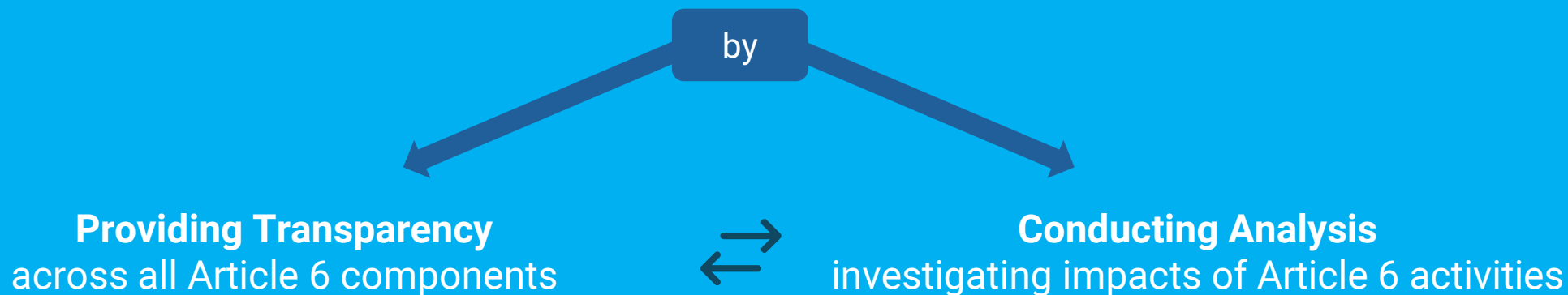

The Article 6 Pipeline is an **open-source database** providing information and analysis based on a variety of sources - **mostly from the UNFCCC and UNEP-CCC's own research**, but also integrating data from other initiatives like **Climate Watch and the Net Zero Tracker**

# Structure and Content

## Article 6 Pipeline Platform

Cooperation agreements, projects, issued units, emission levels and climate targets, sustainable development impacts, and more  
*can be explored across 4 main sections*



### Global Data

---

- Overviews clustered by countries, regions or other country groups (e.g. high income or LDCs)
- Detailed country and region pages linking Article 6 to national targets and priorities (e.g. NDCs and SDGs)



### Activities

---

- Individual projects and programmes (e.g. details from the PDDs)
- Activities and their impacts across sectors, types, GHGs, and more (e.g. projects for agriculture, solar cookstoves or methane abatement)



### Cooperation

---

- Tracing Article 6.2 and PACM activities throughout the activity cycles (e.g. SD Tool report, authorization, or issuances)
- Transactions and ultimate use of the units generated under each of the mechanisms (e.g. ITMOs, Overall mitigation)



### Analysis Hub

---

- Analytical deep dives and explainers (e.g. climate impact from the CDM transition)
- Option to flexibly interact with the data to generate and download your own reports (various graphs and tables with filter options)
